Forty-five religious books, chosen by a committee of librarians as the most important books - for library purposes - in the field of religion published from May 1, 1936, to June 1, 1937, were announced yesterday afternoon at a meeting of the Religious Books Section of the American Library Association, one of the sessions of the fifty-ninth annual conference of the Association now in progress in New York City.

The committee which made the selections was composed of three members representing the theological seminary point of view and three that of the public library, with a chairman representing a special library. Geographically the membership ranged from the New England East, the South, the Middle-West to the Pacific Coast. Included on the committee were Miss Hollis W. Hering, chairman, Missionary Research Library, New York City; Thomas P. Ayer, Richmond (Va.) Public Library; Marguerite Barrett, Denver (Colo.) Public Library; Louise E. Jones, Los Angeles (Calif.) Public Library; John F. Lyons, Presbyterian Theological Seminary Library, Chicago, Illinois; Theodore L. Trost, Colgate-Rochester Divinity School Library, Rochester, New York and O. Gerald Lawson, Drew University Library, Madison, New Jersey, who served ex-officio as chairman of the Religious Books Section.
