The Young Adult Services Division (YASD) of the American Library Association (ALA) announced its "Best Books for Young Adults 1978" list on January 11, 1979, during the ALA Midwinter Meeting in Washington, D.C.

The selection was made by a committee of 15 librarians. Penny Jeffrey was the 1978 "Best Books" Chairperson. The books were chosen on the basis of "their proven or potential appeal and worth to young adults" (12 - 18 years old). To be eligible, books had to be published between November 1, 1977 and October 31, 1978.

This year's list represents a broad range of reading interests, from Black American poetry to horror stories to primary source material from the Native American viewpoint.
