The Resources and Technical Services Division (RTSD) Board of the American Library Association confirmed the appointments of two new editors for RTSD publications.

Elizabeth Tate is the new editor of Library Resources and Technical Services. Tate retired in 1976 after 33 years of federal library work. She was the Chief Descriptive Cataloger in the Library of Congress Processing Department. Tate is interested in receiving suggestions for the winter, 1981 issue, which will be the 25th anniversary of LRTS. She will begin her new position with the Fall, 1979 issue.

Arnold Hirshon, is the new editor of the RTSD Newsletter. He is a cataloger in the Technical Services Department at Duke University. He assumed his new position with the June, 1979 issue. The newsletter will no longer be published quarterly, but will be issued six times a year, beginning January, 1980. The layout of the publication will change with typesetting and a new logo.
