The H. W. Wilson Library Periodical Award, consisting of \$500 and a certificate, was presented to The Southeastern Librarian for "sustained excellence in both content and format." This award was presented at the Inaugural Banquet, June 28, during the Annual Conference of the American Library Association in Dallas.

The citation reads as follows:

By encouraging research pertinent to its area, creating a climate of cooperation, and fostering a sense of regional identity, The Southeastern Librarian contributes to the advance of librarianship in an age of increasing interdependence.
