The 1979 Director of Coordinators of Children's Services and of Young Adult Services in Public Library Systems Serving at Least 100,000 People is now available from the Association for Library Service to Children, a division of the American Library Association. A revision of the 1977 compilation, The Directory is a continuation of a publication originally published by the United States Office of Education. It continues to identify the key staff members in our largest public library systems who develop and coordinate programs for children, preschool through junior high school age, and for young adults of high school age.

The Directory includes 498 public library systems and provides the names of 374 coordinators in the field of children's services and 154 coordinators in the field of young adult services. Information was collected with the assistance of members of the Association of State and Cooperative Library Agencies' State Library Consultants on Public Library Services to Children Discussion Group, Directors of State Library Agencies and their staffs.
