ACRL EXPANDS JOB LISTING ACTIVITIES

A new employment information service, designed to get librarians job opening news quickly and efficiently, will be offered by ACRL beginning January, 1979. The service will supplement the listings which will continue to appear in the C&RL News.

Each month a circular will be available that will list job openings received in the ACRL office during the previous four weeks. There will be a delay of one to four weeks between the time an ad arrives in the ACRL office and when the reader receives it. The cut off date for the receipt of the listings will be the third of each month.

On trial basis this service will be available for free to ACRL members and for \$10 to non-members. Persons participating in the service will receive the mailings for six months. At the end of each six month period, it will be necessary to renew the service.
