Providing Legal Services for Prisoners: A Tool for Correctional Administrators is now available from the Association of Specialized and Cooperative Library Agencies, a division of the American Library Association. The publication is the revised edition of the Guidelines for Legal Reference in Correctional Institutions (1973).

The 52-page booklet was published in 1977 by the American Correctional Association with the cooperation and permission of the American Association of Law Libraries, Special Interest Section on Law Library Service to Institution Residents.

It includes an overview of legal services to prisoners, recommended collections for prison and other institution law libraries, plus directories of law libraries offering service to prisoners and law librarian consultants to correctional institutions.
