William I. Bunnell has been appointed Executive Secretary of the Resources and Technical Services Division of the American Library Association.

Bunnell comes to ALA from the County College of Morris, Dover, New Jersey. As Director of Library Services, he led the development of the library since the college's inception in 1969. Bunnell has also worked at the Bloomfield College Library; the Albert R. Mann Library, Cornell University; Trinity College Library, Hartford; and the University of Chicago Law School Library.

Bunnell has been active in a wide range of professional organizations. He was president of the New Jersey Library Association in 1976-77 and, within the past 10 years, has served in several offices of ALA's Association of College and Research Libraries and Resources and Technical Services Division. From 1968-70 he was vice-president of the American Association of University Professors, County College of Morris Chapter.

Bunnell holds an A.B. in American history from Trinity College, and a M.L.S. from Columbia University.
