and to a fair and equitable
distribution of wealth and
income.

Article 26. (1) Everyone has
the right to education. This
right includes free and
compulsory elementary educa-
tion, and higher education in
the fields of science, literature,
art and sports.

Article 27. (1) Everyone has
the right to the highest attainable
standard of living, which includes
food, clothing, housing, medical
care and social services, and
education, and to a fair and
equitable distribution of wealth
and income.

Article 28. (1) No one shall
be subjected to arbitrary
interference with his privacy,
family, home or correspondence,
nor to attacks on his honor and
reputation.

Article 29. (1) Everyone has
duties to the community. These
duties shall be exercised in
accordance with the principles
of justice and equity.
