

RESOLUTION ON FUNDING FOR THE WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE
ON LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SERVICES II

- WHEREAS, PL 100-382, signed into law in August, 1988, authorizes a second White House Conference on Library and Information Services (WHCLIS II) and authorizes a total of \$6 million to carry out the conference, to be held by September 30, 1991; and
- WHEREAS, Initial funding of \$1,750,000 for WHCLIS II has been included in the FY 1989 supplemental appropriations bill; and
- WHEREAS, The remaining authorized funding of \$4,250,000 is needed for continuing preparatory state plans and activities so that WHCLIS II can indeed be held before September 30, 1991; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the American Library Association express its gratitude to the Senate and House Appropriations Committees for the initial funding of \$1,750,000 for planning of WHCLIS II; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the American Library Association urge the House and Senate Appropriations Committee to provide in the FY 1990 Labor-Health and Human Services-Education Appropriations bill the remaining \$4,250,000 authorized to ensure that WHCLIS II is held before September 30, 1991; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That this resolution be transmitted to the House and Senate Appropriations Committees.
