- --funding patterns by state and territorial library agencies for interlibrary cooperation functions,
- -- communication devices and network hardware,
- --machine readable information data bases,
- --interlibrary services to special user groups,
- --legal bases and barriers for multi-type library cooperation.

In addition, a matrix listing the number of U.S. libraries by type appears in the appendices.
