The Margaret Mann Citation has been presented to Margaret W. Ayrault, professor, Graduate School of Library Studies, University of Hawaii, on Monday, June 30, 1975, during the Annual Conference of the American Library Association in San Francisco, June 29 - July 5. The citation recognizes outstanding achievement in the areas of classification and achievement.

Ms. Ayrault received her A.B. from Oberlin; B.S. from Drexel Institute of Technology; and M.S. in L.S. from Columbia University. Prior to her position at the University of Hawaii, Ms. Ayrault was chief cataloger, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor; assistant librarian, U.S. Bureau of the Budget, Washington, D.C.; Chief, Processing Section, U.S. Department of Agriculture Library; and Chief, Bibliographic Control Section, Technical Library, U.S. Ordnance Test Station, China Lake, California. Ms. Ayrault has been on the ALA Council for three terms; secretary of the Junior Members Round Table; served as executive secretary of the Cataloging and Classification Section of the Resources and Technical Services Division, and served on several committees of RTSD and ALA. She was honored by the Hawaill Legislature in House Resolution 791; received the Beta Phi Mu

Award; and the Phi Beta Kappa, Oberlin Award.
