Millicent Fenwick, immediate past director of the New Jersey State Division of Consumer Affairs will be the featured speaker at the Library Administration Division's Personnel Administration Section's Economic Status, Welfare & Fringe Benefits Committee Program on Tuesday, July 9, at 2 p.m., during the Annual Conference of the American Library Association, in New York City, the week of July 7 - 13, 1974. Her topic will be "The Consumer Movement in 1974".

Ms. Fenwick's outstanding career has included election to the New Jersey General Assembly (1969-73), and work on its subcommittee on consumer protection; chairmanship of Committee on Medical Costs on the New Jersey State Health Planning Council and of the Commission to Study Child Abuse. She also served as a trustee of the New Jersey Historical Society; on the advisory council, Graduate School of Social Work at Rutgers University; and she has been active in prison reform.

Ms. Fenwick is presently running for Congress from New Jersey's 6th Congressional District.
