CSK Task Force Meeting was held on Wednesday, July 1, 1981, 4:30-5:30 P.M., Hilton Hotel, Walnut Room, San Francisco, California.

MINUTES

INTRODUCTION Introductions were made by all in attendance.

CSK AWARD Effie Lee Morris, Chair, expressed delight
BREAKFAST with the CSK Award Breakfast held on Tuesday, June 30, 1981. She stated that it was the best organized breakfast she had ever attended. She also expressed her appreciation to Jean E. Coleman (SRRT Staff Liaison) for her efforts in coordinating activities. It is the hope of the Task Force that the CSK Award Breakfast will become one of the major social events at the ALA annual conferences.

DONORS Although the Task Force have not received written confirmation from the Encyclopedia Britannica-Chicago of their continued support, members of the Task Force have been in contact and their support is expected to continue.

It was reported that the Coca Cola USA (Atlanta, GA) has allocated funds in their budget for the CSK Award.

A formal invitation should be sent to Mr. Raymond Gregory (Gregory Machine and Tool Service-Chicago) inviting him to attend the CSK Award Breakfast in Philadelphia to tell of his relationship with Glydon Greer.

Beatrice James inquired whether the authors and other award recipients write to donors expressing their appreciation. A doubtful response was given, but it was agreed that this was a good idea and something that should be done in the future.

CORRESPONDENCE Ms. Morris asked that task force related correspondence be carboned to Jean E. Coleman and herself.

Ms. Coleman reminded the Task Force that they would be responsible for conducting their own committee business and that if she and her staff continued to spend as much time on the task force, ALA would charge the SRRT an overhead fee.

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- BUDGET** All bills incurred by Task Force should be sent to chair for review. SRRT has allocated the task force an operationing budget of \$300.00. The chair will draw up a budget for this amount and for CSK breakfast funds. Copy of budget will be sent to Staff Liaison and SRRT Treasurer.
- HISTORY AND ARCHIVES COMMITTEE** This Committee has been established and will consist of the following persons: Harriett Brown (chair); Susie Shurney; Mabel McKissick; and Beatrice James.
- SCHEDULE OF BREAKFAST** The Task Force would like the CSK Award Breakfast held on Tuesday of each ALA annual conference. Coleman stated that although SRRT would hold this day open, the final scheduling decision would come from the ALA Conference Arrangements Office.
- BOOK SELECTION COMMITTEE** This seven-member committee will be chaired by Barbara Rollock. Ms. Rollock will develop guidelines for the committee. Susie Shurney expressed an interest in participating on committee.
- PUBLICITY AND PUBLIC INFORMATION** Five thousand CSK Award seals were purchased this year. They are being sold at six (6¢) cents per seal. A fee schedule for quality purchase is needed. Ms. Coleman wants to establish a working relationship with printer and draw up a contract to furnish the seals on a continuous basis. Ms. Coleman will investigate and report to group at Midwinter.
- AWARD WINNERS** The award winning book publishers will be notified in advance so they can provide authors and books for exhibit booth. Chris Hoy (ALA Conference Arrangements) has requested that book sales be limited to exhibit area.
- ADVISORY COMMITTEE** In discussing Advisory Committee, Ms. Coleman pointed out that committee members should also be members of the Social Responsibilities Round Table. Ms. Morris was uncertain of the function of this committee. Goal and objectives need to be developed. Mrs. James and Mrs. Brown will compile list of past members.
- LOCAL ARRANGEMENTS** John Cunningham (Philadelphia, PA) was suggested as possible local arrangements person for the Philadelphia conference.

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PROGRAM COMMITTEE: Members of the 1982 CSK Award Program Committee are: E. J. Josey; Barbara Rollock; Harriett Brown and Effie Lee Morris.

MIDWINTER MEETING ** The CSK Award Task Force meeting has been tentatively scheduled for Saturday, January 23 from 8:30-10:30 P.M.

CSK BREAKFAST CSK Award Breakfast is scheduled for Tuesday, July 13, 1982 at 7:30 A.M.

CORETTA SCOTT KING Mrs. Shurney requested permission to write to Mrs. King to learn of her interest in the award; to let her know how it has grown in popularity; and the success of the breakfast. Permission was granted.

ADJOURNMENT Meeting adjourned on schedule.
