

By Libba Bray

Libba Bray's best-selling Diviners series comes to a thundering, much-anticipated conclusion in *The King of Crows*, which released last month. In it, Bray's ragtag group of teens finds themselves scattered across America, and what started as a historical ghost story spirals into a tale that reckons with the uglier side of U.S. history and condemns ideas of inequality. Bray's large fan base will likely be looking for something new now that this YA quartet is finished, so recommend her previous titles, found below, as well as *Iron Cast*, by Destiny Soria and *The Last Magician*, by Lisa Maxwell for a similar mix of occultism and glamour in the early twentieth century.



THE SHELF CARE INTERVIEW: IRENE LATHAM AND CHARLES WATERS




