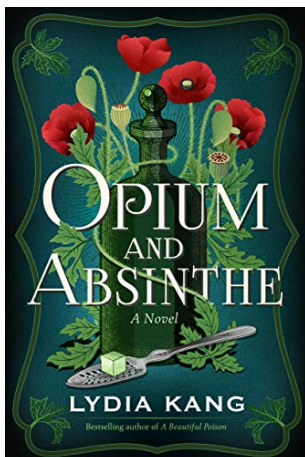

## Opium and Absinthe

Creatively and scientifically minded, Lydia Kang is both a physician and an author of adult fiction, YA fiction, nonfiction, and poetry. Those talents combine in her latest novel, *Opium and Absinthe*, which compassionately tackles the topic of opioid addiction within the context of an historical mystery during New York City's Gilded Age. When Tillie Pembroke's sister is found dead and drained of blood, Tillie must determine whether the killer is a vampire—like the one in Bram Stoker's recently released *Dracula*—or someone even more macabre. As Tillie becomes increasingly addicted to laudanum, she teams up with a handsome newsie to try and hunt for the truth. For other sensitive depictions of sleuths who are struggling with addiction, try Abir Mukherjee's *A Rising Man* or Alex Segura's *Blackout*.
