**Bogle International Library Travel Grant recipient named**

Ann Joyner, librarian for the Santa Rita Unit of the Arizona Prison Complex in Tucson, is the 1993 recipient of the American Library Association (ALA) International Relations Committee Bogle International Library Travel Grants.

The grant, \$500 donated by the Bogle Memorial Fund, is given to librarians to travel abroad to attend conferences.

Joyner will be among a U.S. delegation of professionals in adult and juvenile correctional education which will travel to Russia and Czechoslovakia. They will attend an international conference on prison education scheduled for June 21-29, 1993.

Under the auspices of the Correctional Education Association and the Citizen Ambassador Program of People to People International, the U.S. delegation will visit a variety of schools and correctional facilities in and around St. Petersburg, Moscow and Prague to examine a number of correctional education systems.
