**ALSC publishes updated children's/young adult services coordinators directory**

The 8th edition of "Coordinators of Children's and Young Adult Services in Public Library Systems Serving at Least 100,000 People, January 1993" has been published by the Association for Library Service to Children (ALSC), a division of the American Library Association (ALA).

The directory will enable the user to identify the developers and coordinators of programs for children (birth through junior high) and young adults (high school age) in the largest public library systems in the country. Contact names are also provided for several libraries where youth service coordinators have not been designated.

The directory, which gives an overview of the status of children's and youth adult services as reflected in staffing patterns, can be used as a tool for networking, surveys and direct mail.
