Richard P. Smiraglia named editor of Library Resources & Technical Services

Richard P. Smiraglia, associate professor at the Palmer School of Library and Information Science, Long Island University, has been appointed to a second term as editor of Library Resources & Technical Services (LRTS), a journal of the Assocation for Library Collections & Technical Services (ALCTS).

His books include "Origins, Contents and the Future of AACR2 Revised"(1992), "Describing Archival Materials" (1990) and "Music Cataloging" (1989). Smiraglia is currently working on a third edition of "Music Cataloging."

He has a master's degree in library science from Indiana University, Bloomington, and a doctorate from the University of Chicago.
