- The ALA finance department recently informed all business units that
 February performance reports will be available July 7th. ALA is looking at a
 different way of getting financials due to the problems with the firm that was
 doing.
- Still no update for membership numbers.
- Online revenue continues to be strong.
- Virtual Program featured 2 RUSA programs. ALA Virtual had around 7,000 registered. Should have final RUSA numbers soon.
- July 9 Carnegie Awards will be virtual.
- RUSA had a town hall on June 9th with over 100 registrants as an update.
 Upcoming town halls have been scheduled from 12 –1 p.m. CT for Tuesday,
 July 14th (Definition of Reference) and Tuesday, August 11th (RUSA Futures Task Force update).
- ALA Staff are beginning to come in to unpack. September 8 is the full return date. There will be furloughs (6 weeks total 1 week in FY20; rest in FY21).

- Best practices for virtual reference/instruction in light of Covid-19. Perhaps build upon previous guidelines and talk about being proactive. Also drop-in versus scheduled.
- Town Hall could alternate between our RUSA business and topical areas. Could have tips and/or town hall and/or webinar. This came up in Vice-Chairs meeting. Could be a hot topic.

For Ed:

- Ask what is happening with advocacy in terms of librarians being scared to return to work in areas where safety is in question. Advocacy for library service workers.
- How can RUSA be part of the initiative for libraries in the time of Covid? Easier for us to talk
 about what is happening rather than why. Guidance when patron not wearing a mask.
 Focus on service level. Go beyond materials.

On paper, divisions have assets but ALA is using this money to pay expenses. Money is not there today but if things improve financially we may get back.

Hope we can have a RUSA rep on new working group on operating agreement. Could percentage taken be negotiated since 26% of our budget? Hard for divisions to stay afloat.

Our finances are not realistic. Do we have any future if not reality based? Wonderful to have enthusiasm but we need money to survive.

Operating agreement and membership structure both being looked at. Division budgets need to be thought of in a new way. The budgeting practices of the past have not worked. What are the opportunities? How do we advocate our functions in light of the budgeting process?

Important to closely monitor the operating agreement and our contacts on the group.

We need to rethink how we think about our affinity groups within ALA.

ALA Council 3 discussed SCOE recommendations and moving forward. ALA Council was asked to take ownership of governance recommendations. Council will meet more frequently. One recommendation was that all bylaws be at the top level as well as dissolution of Council. Division councilors do have limited conversations separately from overall council

Do we know which Council members are in RUSA? What can we advocate with Council on behalf of our community of practice?

There is some detail on cost reduction strategies including furloughs. Board meeting dates may have to be rethought due to furloughs.
