ACRL/CJCLS AWARD WINNERS

Charles R. Peguese, assistant dean of instructional resources and director of McCormick Library, Harrisburg Area Community College, has been selected to receive the CJCLS Leadership or Community Services Award. Peguese's activities reflect a variety of involvements that place the LRC in the forefront of public awareness. The breadth of his leadership is impressive and includes

fostering cooperative services, designing systems for cooperation among academic libraries, and the use of technology to provide services for an entire community. The recognition accorded to him by local and statewide leaders is impressive.

The Cooperative Collection Development Committee of the Chemeketa Cooperative Regional Library Service (CCRLS), Chemeketa Community College, Salem, Oregon has been awarded the CJCLS Program Development Award.

CCRLS is an outstanding example of different types of libraries cooperatively developing collections to enhance the resources available to a diversified constituency. This coalition used a variety of tools and techniques from newsletters to videos and floats in a farm fest to advertise the resources purchased through a cooperative grant award. The Cooperative Collection Development Committee has made extraordinary progress toward the development of a system-wide collection development policy involving academic and public libraries.
