

RESOLUTION ON REAUTHORIZATION OF LSCA

- WHEREAS, Representative Paul Simon, Chairman of the House Postsecondary Education Subcommittee, has afforded the library community the unique opportunity to comment on a discussion draft to amend and extend LSCA before introduction of a bill; and
- WHEREAS, LSCA reflects an appropriate federal role in assisting in strengthening and improving library and information services and is deserving of continuation; and
- WHEREAS, the new priorities and emphasis in the discussion draft respond to the changing needs for library and information sciences as expressed by the library community and many library users; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, that the ALA express its appreciation to Rep. Paul Simon for the open process used in the development of the LSCA discussion draft and express its appreciation for the opportunity to be involved in the process; and, be it
- FURTHER RESOLVED, that ALA strongly support the priorities and concepts in the discussion draft to amend and extend LSCA, and offer its assistance to the House Postsecondary Education Subcommittee as the draft further develops.
