1. Changes since our last report

No changes to the Standard Citation Forms (SCF) roster to report.

2. Statistics

Since our last report – January 20, 2023 – we have published 18 new citation forms and made corrections to 2 existing citations. New and updated citations continue to be announced monthly on DCRM-L.

Between January and May 2023, the SCF site averaged 1,418 sessions, 812 users, 609 new users, and 2,920 page views each month, similar usage compared to the same period the previous year.

3. Linked Data

As previously reported, the SCF team reviewed Yale's report on their project converting the standard citations to Wikidata and decided to move forward adding these to the database. The process of adding these Wikidata URIs to the citation records is now complete. Special thanks to the entire SCF team for their help on this project.

The next phase of this work will be to establish procedures for creating Wikidata entities for new standard citations as well as those created since the completion of Yale's project. A small subgroup, consisting of Stephanie Fell, Gina Solares, and Matthew Ducmanas, met in early June to begin working on this. We look forward to sharing more information as this work continues.
