A Tribute Resolution Honoring Nathan Scott

Whereas Nathan Scott, a Library & Museum Assistant, was working at the Strozier Library on the Florida State University campus when an armed gunman began shooting on November 20, 2014;

Whereas over 300 students and library employees were present at the library at the time of the attack; and

Whereas after being shot in the leg he acted courageously by running into the library to warn others of the danger; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the American Library Association (ALA), on behalf of its members:

1. recognizes Nathan Scott's courage in the face of mortal danger; and
2. expresses its appreciation and gratitude for those actions which may have saved the lives of students and library staff and wishes him well in his recovery.
