The RUSA Financial Literacy Interest Group (FLIG) brings together library professionals from all library types who provide financial literacy resources to their patrons through collections, programming, and partnerships.

FLIG typically hosts online discussions and webinars quarterly which have featured member presentations of financial literacy efforts at their libraries, and information sessions from financial literacy resource providers such as the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau and the Commodity Futures Trading Commission.

Additionally, FLIG maintains a public LibGuide (https://libguides.ala.org/finraore/personalfinance), sponsored by the FINRA Investor Education Foundation, which gives library professionals recommendations for books, periodicals, websites, and program ideas that support financial literacy development in library settings. Past webinar recordings are also available on the LibGuide.
