- Acquired in 1969: Nucleus was the 7,500-hardback book collection from Dr. J. Lloyd Eaton's estate
- Presently more than 300,000 items
- Over 100,000 hardback and paperback books.
- Full runs of most sf pulp magazines.
- Film and visual material, including 500 shooting scripts from science fiction films.
- More than 50,000 Comic books, anime and manga.
- Nearly 100,000 individual issues of fanzines.
- Collectible ephemera and realia, including cards, posters, pins and action figures.
- SF writers' archives: Anne McCaffrey, Robert Forward, Gregory Benford, David Brin, Vernor Vinge et al.
