3. Financial report

A. Update on the Leab account

The Endowment account balance is \$47,726. It may reach ACRL's required threshold of \$50,000 this year, and should reach the threshold within the deadline.

B. Current expenditures

Committee members should submit shipping reimbursements to Johnston as soon as possible.

6. Review of 2016 award cycle

There was one late submission this year, but it is eligible for the 2017 awards cycle and will be resubmitted. Overall, there were less submissions than past years; the committee reviewed listservs and other venues where the call for submissions is publicized to make sure the call is reaching the appropriate audience.

There were concerns about 2016 submissions that did not meet the award eligibility requirements. The committee discussed the current language describing the awards and the committee charge as it appears online, but felt that the language was clear and does not need revision.
