## Standard Citation Forms Editorial Team report Bibliographic Standards Committee January 16, 2024 meeting Reported by: Stephanie Fell and Gina Solares

## 1. Changes since our last report

Since our last report at Annual, we did not have any new members join the Standard Citation Forms (SCF) Editorial Team. Outgoing members include: Emily Baldoni, Lori Dekydtspotter, Kate Moriarty, and Noah Sheola. We thank our outgoing members for their work on the SCF Editorial Team. Rafael Linares Blasini continues to serve as our Web Team Liaison. We appreciate his willingness to continue to serve in this role.

In July 2023, current member Gina Solares rotated on as the new co-editor. We thank Gina for agreeing to serve and also express warm thanks to the outgoing co-editor, Matt Ducmanas, for his service and on-going assistance as a member of SCF.

## 2. Statistics

Since our last report on June 20, 2023 we have published 27 new citation forms. New and updated citations continue to be announced monthly on DCRM-L.

During the calendar year 2023, the SCF site averaged 4912 views and 877 users per month. These numbers are up a bit from last year; however, we no longer have access to Google Analytics statistics due to a platform change and the built-in SCF site statistics offers some less granular metrics.

## 3. Linked Data

In June 2023, SCF convened a Wikidata subgroup, consisting of co-editors Stephanie Fell and Gina Solares, as well as team member Matt Ducmanas, to consider how to build upon work done during Yale's <a href="PCC Wikidata Pilot project">PCC Wikidata Pilot project</a> to convert standard citations entries to Wikidata.

As previously reported, in response to the Yale project, SCF created a new Wikidata URI field in the SCF database and added Wikidata Edition entity URIs to each citation in the SCF database. The subgroup has added an additional 84 SCF entries created since the conclusion of the Yale Pilot to Wikidata. We have been meeting regularly to develop a workflow for continuing to add new SCF entries to Wikidata in the future.

We will continue to share more information as this work evolves.
