CC:DA had their 2024 Winter Virtual Meeting February 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Here is a very high-level summary of the meeting:

# - PCC Liaison Report

# - Library of Congress Representative Report

- Paul Frank is working 90% on the Library Collections Access Platform (LCAP) project
  - Tricia Mackenzie is the NACO coordinator
  - Heidy Berthoud is the SACO coordinator
- ClassWebPlus updates are now done on a regular basis; rather than being constrained by the quarterly update schedule that was part of Catalogers Desktop
- Analysis and revisions of the LC-PCC RDA Policy Statements and Metadata Guidance Documents is ongoing
- Those interested are welcome to attend the monthly Subject Editorial meetings
- The LCGFT Advisory Group has been formed
- The <u>BIBFRAME Update Forum</u> took place on January 22, 2024
- The <u>PCC Working Group on Metadata Application Profiles</u> is working on an RDA application profile

# CC:DA Documents Online Repository Task Force Report

- Discussion:
  - Is it worthwhile to archive official blog or wiki discussions (if retrievable) which led to official documents?
    - It is helpful to know what people were saying when the decision was made
    - This is an important part of CC:DA's and RDA's history
  - Does CC:DA want a blog?
    - This would mean maintaining another web space outside of Connect
    - Decision was made to retire the blog
- There are over 1000 documents to be archived
- Discussion of IFLA ISBD for Manifestation Review Call ISBD for Manifestation Task Force

- o ISBD for Manifestation (ISBDM) draft
  - There will be an opportunity to comment on this draft during the IFLA worldwide review
  - ISBDM will only be available online
  - CC:DA needs to start planning their response
    - It was moved, seconded and voted to create a Task Force to study and respond to this document
    - Interested CC:DA members should send their names to the Chair

 OCLC will begin adding WorldCat Entity URIs for Works to 758 fields in WorldCat bibliographic records

## - CC:DA Report

- Documents Task Force A Google document will be set up to keep track of documentation that members might have that is not on the blog
- A Task Force will be set up to create a CC:DA onboarding package
- CC:DA Task Force on Personal Names in Official RDA is currently looking at options available for personal compound surnames and initials
- Next CC:DA meeting will be held in person at ALA San Diego
  - Historically the meetings have been held on Saturday afternoon and Monday morning (2 x 3.0 hour meetings)
  - There currently is not the capacity to do hybrid meetings although it is still being investigated
