RBMS COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT DISCUSSION GROUP June 16, 2020 Minutes

- How do you intend to respond to faculty requests for new materials?
- How will new incoming materials be handled?

The co-conveners proposed that the group discuss ways to ensure a diverse and inclusive collection at the next meeting to be held at Midwinter.
