During the meeting, the educators described their districts' connectivity status and goals, the impact of limited bandwidth, prices paid for services, and impact of potential cuts to voice services. The educators also discussed proposals to streamline the applications system, including the possibility of using a district-wide discount level for P1 applications. All educators agreed that increasing E-Rate's annual cap should be a priority for the Commission.
