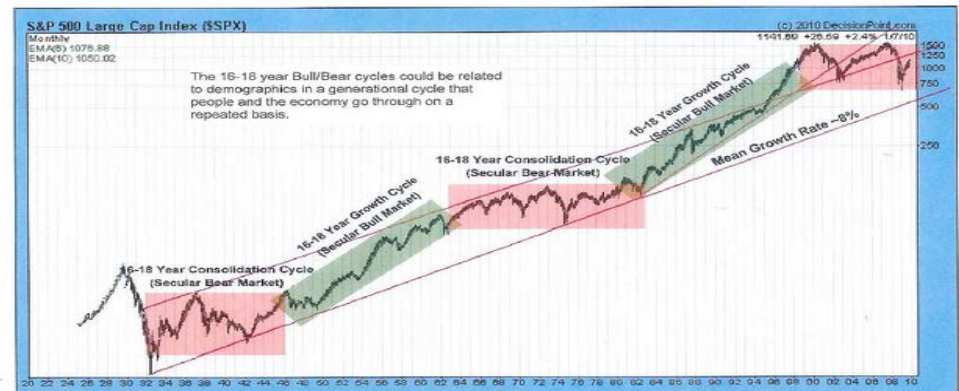

Federal Reserve continues to hint at a future rate increase

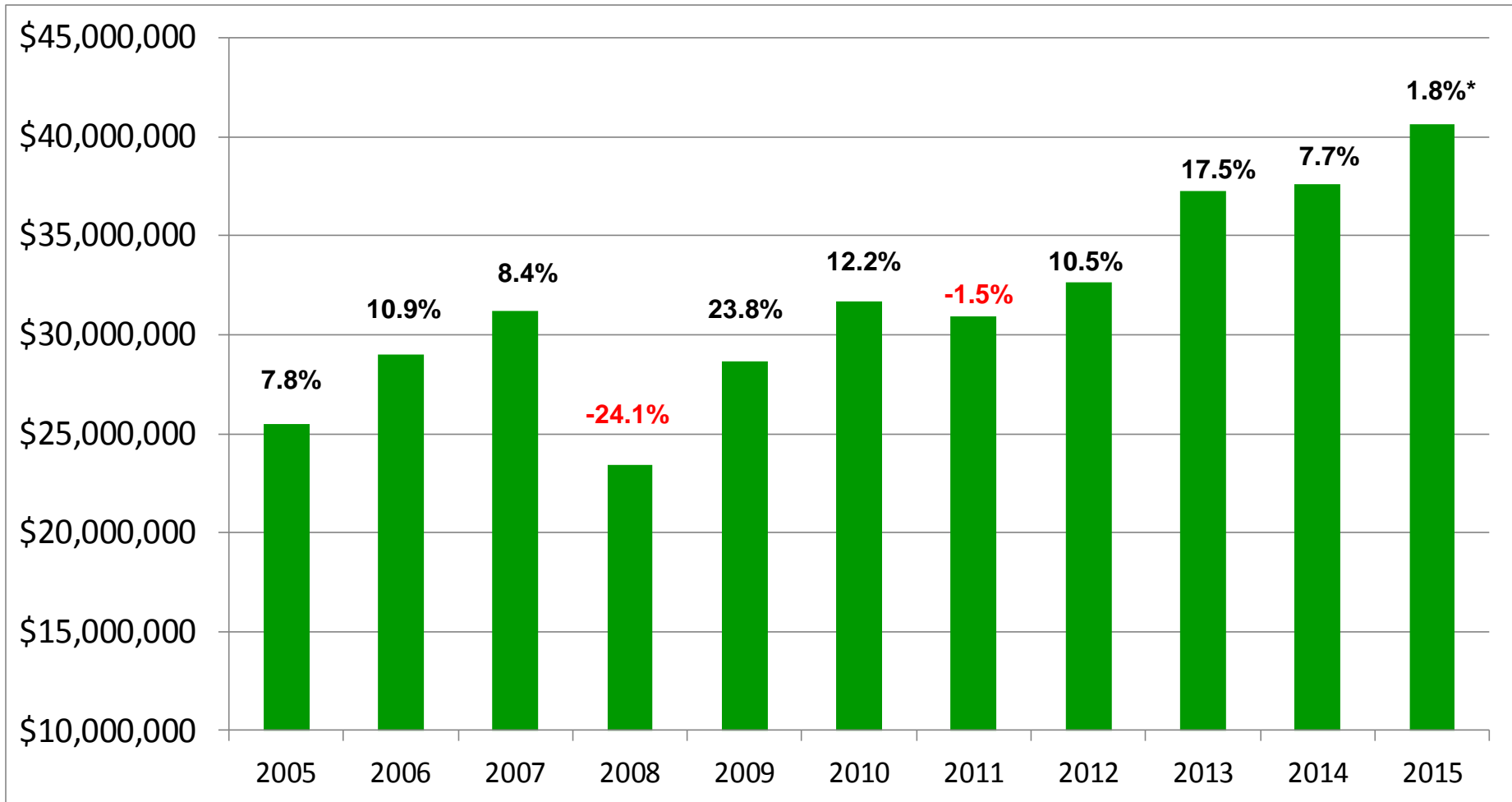

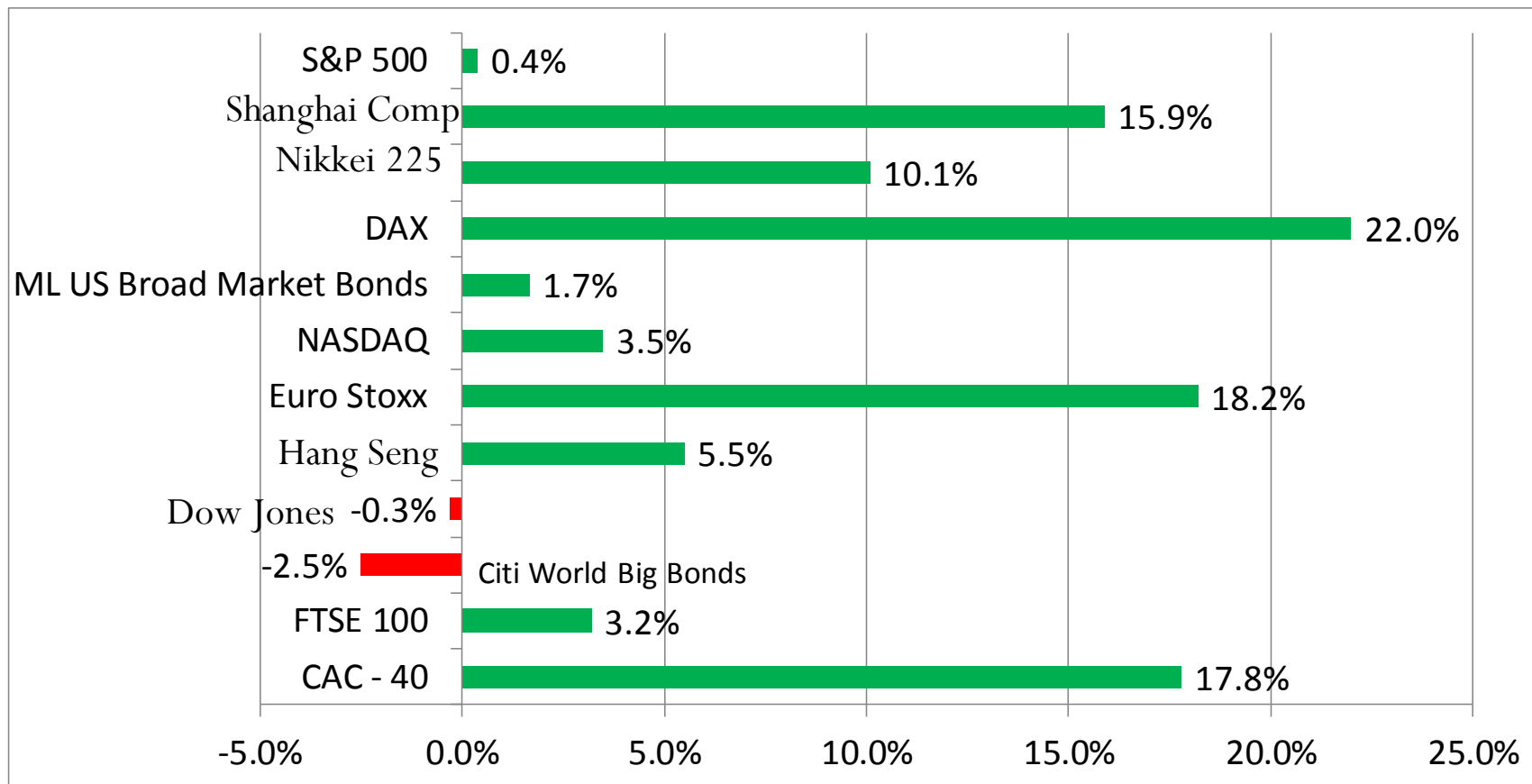
