An interpersonal communications workshop will be part of the Annual Conference of the American Library Association in San Francisco, June 29 through July 5.

The participatory workshop, sponsored by the Library Administration Division's Personnel Administration Section Staff Development Committee and the Junior Member's Round Table of the ALA, will be held Sunday, June 29, from 8 to 4.

Purpose of the workshop is to develop the skills needed for effective interpersonal communication on the job. Workshop participants will have an opportunity to practice these skills during the sessions.

Workshop leader will be Dr. Eva Schindler-Rainman, international communications consultant. Ms. Schindler-Rainman received her doctorate in social work, and her master in social work at the University of Southern California; and her B.A. at the University of California, Berkeley, School of Social Welfare. Her many honors and awards include: American Men and Women of Science; National Institute of Mental Health Career Teacher Award; Ford Foundation Fellowship; Phi Kappa Phi; The Two Thousand Women of Achievement; and Who's Who in American Women. Among her positions at the University of California at Los Angeles, she has been Assistant

Head, Education Extension; Coordinator, Social Welfare Extension; and on the Faculty, School of Social Welfare. Ms. Schindler-Rainman served on the faculty, School of Social Work, University of California; has been Director, Personnel Services, and Director, Training, Girl Scouts, for the Los Angeles Council; and also West Coast Youth Director for the National Conference of Christians and Jews, San Francisco. She is the author of The Volunteer Community: Creative Uses of Human Resources (co-authored with Ronald Lippitt) and The Images of Potentiality.
