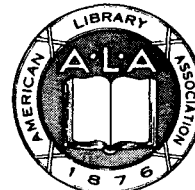

RESOLUTION ON EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FOR THE WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE ON LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SERVICES II

- WHEREAS, PL 100-382, signed into law in August, 1988, authorized a second White House Conference on Library and Information Services (WHCLIS II) to be held by September 30, 1991; and
- WHEREAS, Approximately \$5 million of the \$6 million in federal funds authorized for WHCLIS II has been appropriated, and planning has begun, including some state level pre-conference activity; and
- WHEREAS, The published announcement for the position of WHCLIS Executive Director did not include as a qualification any knowledge of or experience in library and information services; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the American Library Association recommend that the U. S. National Commission on Libraries and Information Science appoint promptly an Executive Director of the White House Conference on Library and Information Services who is a librarian with proven experience in both management and library and information services.
