## Winners Announced in ALA Centennial Membership Sweepstakes

Forty eight members of the American Library Association were declared winners in the ALA's Centennial Membership Sweepstakes. The major awards of the membership recruitment campaign were announced by Fred Glazer, ALA Membership Chairperson, during the Centennial Conference in Chicago, July 18 - 24, 1976.

Mr. Glazer also expressed appreciation to the publishers, suppliers and friends of ALA, who generously donated the prizes for the promotion which brought in hundreds of new members.

The major sweepstakes prize, round trip tickets for two to London, was won by Ginny Martin of Indiana University. Ms. Martin recruited 70 new members. The other top winners were Peter Eisenberg of Drexel University who won tickets to the Virgin Islands for recruiting 59 members; Mary McSwain of the University of Texas who will travel to Mexico as her reward for bringing in 40 new members; and Sara Long, librarian at Abbott Junior High School in Elgin, Illinois, who recruited 37 members and will receive a leather chair and ottoman contributed by Gunlocke Company.
