  - A. Coptic bindings
    1. Approved scope note: Use for bindings with gatherings linked by chain or kettle stitches and sewn through holes in boards, which are traditionally made of wood or layers of papyrus. They are historically associated with Egypt and Ethiopia from the 4th to 11th centuries. Spines may be exposed or lined.
  - B. Cathedral bindings
    1. Approved scope note: Use for bindings, especially those produced in France or England in the first half of the 19th century, the decoration of which features motifs derived from Gothic architecture.
